

WITH A POINTED COLLAR

a new zig-zag pattern for this jumper

A MOST unusual stitch is used for this charming jumper with its pretty pointed collar. The colour of the original model was soft blue, but there are lots of other shades for you to choose from.

MATERIALS: 9 ozs. Paton's Super (or "Beehive") Scotch Fingering, 3-ply (original uses blue, No. 1304). A pair No. 12, a pair No. 10, and four No. 9 "Beehive" needles.

MEASUREMENTS: To fit 33-35-inch bust; length from top of shoulder, 19½ inches; sleeve seam, 18½ inches.

TENSION: 7 stitches to an inch, measured over pattern patted out lightly, but not pressed.

BACK

With No. 12 needles, cast on 118 stitches.
1ST ROW: * p. 4, k. 2; repeat from * to

last 4 stitches, p. 4. 2ND ROW: * k. 4, p. 2; repeat from * to last 4 stitches, k. 4. Repeat these 2 rows 16 more times, ending with 1st row.

Change to No. 10 needles and continue thus:—1ST ROW: Back of work facing: (k. 4, p. 2) 9 times, k. 3, p. 4, k. 3 (p. 2, k. 4) 9 times. 2ND ROW: (p. 4, k. 2) 9 times, p. 3, k. 4, p. 3, (k. 2, p. 4) 9 times. 3RD ROW: As 1st.

4TH ROW: (p. 3, k. 3) 9 times, p. 2, k. 6, p. 2, (k. 3, p. 3) 9 times. 5TH ROW: (k. 3, p. 3) 9 times, k. 2, p. 6, k. 2, (p. 3, k. 3) 9 times. 6TH ROW: As 4th.

7TH ROW: (k. 2, p. 4) 9 times, k. 1, knit twice into next stitch, p. 6, knit twice into next stitch, k. 1, (p. 4, k. 2) 9 times. 8TH ROW: (p. 2, k. 4) 9 times, p. 2, k. 8, p. 2, (k. 4, p. 2) 9 times. 9TH ROW: (k. 2, p. 4) 9 times, k. 2, p. 8, k. 2 (p. 4, k. 2) 9 times.

10TH ROW: (p. 1, k. 5) 9 times, p. 1, k. 10, p. 1, (k. 5, p. 1) 9 times. 11TH ROW: (k. 1, p. 5) 9 times, k. 1, p. 10, k. 1, (p. 5, k. 1) 9 times. 12TH ROW: As 10th.

13TH ROW: (p. 5, k. 1) 9 times, p. 5, k. 2, p. 5, (k. 1, p. 5) 9 times. 14TH ROW: (k. 5, p. 1) 9 times, k. 5, p. 2, k. 5, (p. 1, k. 5) 9 times. 15TH ROW: As 13th.

16TH ROW: (k. 4, p. 2) 9 times, k. 4, p. 4, k. 4 (p. 2, k. 4) 9 times.

17TH ROW: p. 4, increasing in 1st stitch, k. 2 (p. 4, k. 2) 8 times, p. 4, k. 4, p. 4, (k. 2, p. 4) 8 times, k. 2, p. 4, increasing in last stitch. (Note: Increase at each end of every following 6th row, taking care to

keep continuity of pattern.) 18TH ROW: p. 1, (k. 4, p. 2) 9 times, k. 4, p. 4, k. 4, (p. 2, k. 4) 9 times, p. 1.

19TH ROW: k. 1, (p. 3, k. 3) 9 times, p. 3, k. 6, p. 3, (k. 3, p. 3) 9 times, k. 1. 20TH ROW: p. 1, (k. 3, p. 3) 9 times, k. 3, p. 6, k. 3, (p. 3, k. 3) 9 times, p. 1. 21ST ROW: As 19th.

22ND ROW: p. 1, (k. 2, p. 4) 9 times, k. 2, p. 8, k. 2, (p. 4, k. 2) 9 times, p. 1.

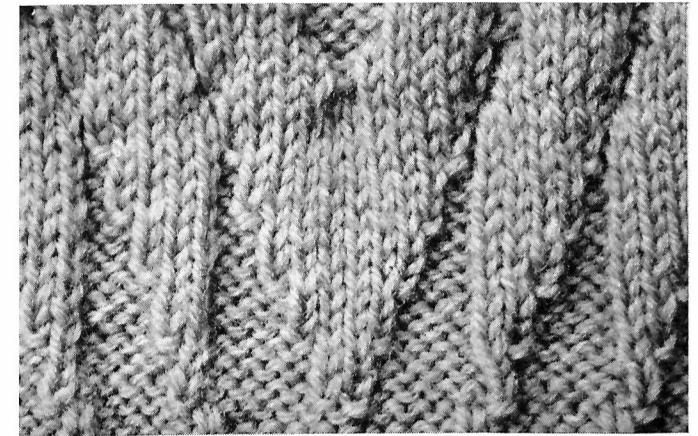
23RD ROW: Increase in 1st stitch (p. 2, k. 4) 9 times, p. 2, k. 8, p. 2, (k. 4, p. 2) 9 times, increase in last stitch. 24TH ROW: As 22nd, but beginning and ending with p. 2.

25TH ROW: k. 2, (p. 1, k. 5) 9 times, p. 1, k. 10, p. 1, (k. 5, p. 1) 9 times, k. 2. 26TH ROW: p. 2, (k. 1, p. 5) 9 times, k. 1, p. 10, k. 1, (p. 5, k. 1) 9 times, p. 2. 27TH ROW: As 25th.

28TH ROW: p. 1, k. 1, (p. 5, k. 1) 9 times, p. 5, k. 2, p. 5, (k. 1, p. 5) 9 times, k. 1, p. 1. 29TH ROW: Increase in 1st stitch, p. 1, (k. 5, p. 1) 9 times, k. 5, p. 2, k. 5, (p. 1, k. 5) 9 times, p. 1, increase in last stitch. 30TH ROW: As 28th row, but p. 2 instead of p. 1 at each end of needle.

Now work as from 1st pattern row, remembering to allow for the side increases and that there are 12 instead of 10 stitches in centre group. Do not increase again in centre of 7th row, but continue those at side-edges in every 6th row.

When there are 142 stitches on needle carry on straight until work measures 12½



inches from commencement. Here shape armhole. Keeping continuity of pattern, cast off 6 stitches at beginning of next 2 rows, then k. 2 tog. at each end of next 10 rows.

Carry on straight in pattern until work measures 18½ inches from commencement. Cast off 9 stitches at beginning of next 8 rows. Cast off remaining stitches.

FRONT

Work exactly as for back until 17 inches have been done from commencement. Here shape for the neck. Work 49, cast off 12. Work 49.

Continuing on last 49 stitches only, k. 2 tog. at neck-edge on every row until 36 remain. Carry on straight until the work measures 18½ inches from commencement. Now with back of work towards you, cast off 9 stitches at beginning of next 4 rows at armhole edge until all are gone.

Work remaining 49 stitches to correspond.

SLEEVES

With No. 12 needles, cast on 54 stitches and work 3 inches in k. 2, p. 2 rib. Change to No. 10 needles and pattern.

1ST ROW: (Back of work facing), k. 2, (p. 1, k. 5) 4 times, p. 2, (k. 5, p. 1) 4 times, k. 2. 2ND ROW: p. 2, (k. 1, p. 5) 4 times, k. 2, (p. 5, k. 1) 4 times, p. 2. 3RD ROW: As 1st.

4TH ROW: p. 1, (k. 2, p. 4) 4 times, k. 4,
