

OUTSTANDINGLY CHIC!

plain ribbing with slick stripes

GAY stripes relieve the classic simplicity of this chic cardigan-jumper. A lovely blue misty shade is used for the plain ribbing; the stripes are in rust, yellow and light blue—the season's smartest shades. The little pockets are a new feature.

MATERIALS: 17 ozs. PATONS SUPER BOUCLET, 14 ozs. of storm blue, No. 3136; 1 oz. each of rust, No. 1230; yellow, No. 2245; and light blue, No. 3132. A pair No. 12 "Isis" needles. Seven buttons or wooden button moulds.

MEASUREMENTS: To fit 34–36-inch bust; length from top of shoulder, 19 inches; sleeve seam, 19 inches (the pattern "goes up" rather).

TENSION: 10 stitches to an inch.

BACK

Using storm blue wool, cast on 110 stitches and work 2 inches in k. 1, p. 1 rib. Now, still working in rib, increase at each end of next and every following 4th row until there are 166 stitches on the needle. Work straight until back measures 12½ inches from bottom edge. Here shape armholes. Cast off 8 stitches at beginning

of next 2 rows, then k. 2 tog. at each end of every row until 134 stitches remain.

Carry on straight until back measures 18½ inches, then shape shoulder by casting off 20 stitches at beginning of next 4 rows. Cast off.

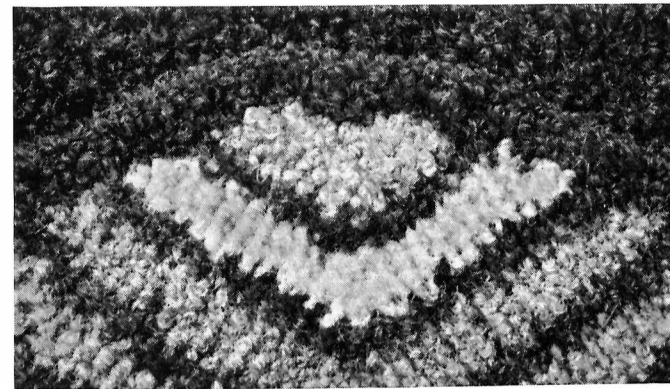
LEFT FRONT

Cast on 65 stitches and work 2 inches straight in rib. Now increase at side edge in next and every following 4th row until there are 93 stitches on the needle. Work straight until front is same length as back, then cast off 8 stitches at shaped edge; now k. 2 tog. at this edge on every row until 67 remain.

Work straight on these stitches until front edge measures 17½ inches. Now cast off 12 stitches on next row at neck edge, then k. 2 tog. at this edge on every row until 40 remain. Carry on straight until front is same length as back, then shape shoulder by casting off 20 stitches at beginning of next 2 rows at armhole edge.

RIGHT FRONT

Before starting, mark position of buttons with pins on left front. Right front is worked to correspond with left, shaping at opposite ends of needles, but with the addition of buttonholes. To make a buttonhole, rib 5, cast off 3, rib to end and back,



casting on 3 stitches to replace those cast off in previous row.

SLEEVES

Cast on 52 stitches and work 2 inches in rib. Now increase at each end of next and every following 6th row to 78 stitches, then at each end of every following 4th row until there are 112 stitches on the needle. Work straight until sleeve is required length, then shape top by casting off 8 stitches at beginning of next 2 rows, then decrease at beginning of every row until 70 stitches remain. Work straight for 4½ more inches; cast off.

COLLAR. Wind small balls of each colour as follows: 10 storm blue, 4 light blue, 4 rust, 2 yellow, and a larger ball of storm blue. Always twist the wools at back of work when changing colour. Cast on 130 stitches in storm blue and rib 2 rows. 3RD ROW: Rib 2 blue, 35 rust, 56 blue, 35 rust, 2 blue. 4TH, 5TH AND 6TH ROWS: As 3rd.

7TH AND 8TH ROWS: Rib 2 blue, 4 rust, 118 blue, 4 rust, 2 blue. 9TH, 10TH, 11TH AND 12TH ROWS: Rib 2 blue, 4 rust, 2 blue, 28 light blue, 58 blue, 28 light blue, 2 blue, 4 rust, 2 blue. 13TH AND 14TH ROWS: Rib 2 blue, 4 rust, 2 blue, 4 light blue, 106 blue, 4 light blue, 2 blue, 4 rust, 2 blue. 15TH, 16TH, 17TH AND 18TH ROWS: 2 blue, 4 rust, 2 blue, 4 light blue, 2 blue, 21 yellow, 60 blue, 21 yellow, 2 blue, 4 light blue, 2 blue, 4 rust, 2 blue.

19TH AND 20TH ROWS: 2 blue, 4 rust,

2 blue, 4 light blue, 2 blue, 4 yellow, 94 blue, 4 yellow, 2 blue, 4 light blue, 2 blue, 4 rust, 2 blue. 21ST, 22ND, 23RD AND 24TH ROWS: 2 blue, 4 rust, 2 blue, 4 light blue, 2 blue, 4 yellow, 2 blue, 14 rust, 62 blue, 14 rust, 2 blue, 4 yellow, 2 blue, 4 light blue, 2 blue, 4 rust, 2 blue.

25TH AND 26TH ROWS: 2 blue, 4 rust, 2 blue, 4 light blue, 2 blue, 4 yellow,

2 blue, 4 rust, 82 blue, 4 rust, 2 blue, 4 yellow, 2 blue, 4 light blue, 2 blue, 4 rust, 2 blue. 27TH, 28TH, 29TH AND 30TH ROWS: 2 blue, 4 rust, 2 blue, 4 light blue, 2 blue, 4 yellow, 2 blue, 4 rust, 2 blue, 7 light blue, 64 blue, 7 light blue, 2 blue, 4 rust, 2 blue, 4 yellow, 2 blue, 4 light blue, 2 blue, 4 rust, 2 blue. Now work in storm blue rib until collar is 3 inches deep. Cast off.

CUFFS. Cast on 51 stitches in storm blue and work 1 row in k. 1, p. 1 rib.

2ND ROW: Rust wool—rib 24, slip 1, k. 2 tog., p.s.s.o., rib 24. 3RD ROW: Rib 47, p. 2 tog. 4TH ROW: Rib 22, slip 1, k. 2 tog., p.s.s.o., rib 21, k. 2 tog. 5TH ROW: Rib 43, p. 2 tog. 6TH ROW: Storm blue wool—rib 20, slip 1, k. 2 tog., p.s.s.o., rib 19, k. 2 tog. 7TH ROW: Rib 39, p. 2 tog. 8TH ROW: Light blue wool—rib 18, slip 1, k. 2 tog., p.s.s.o., rib 17, k. 2 tog. 9TH ROW: Rib 35, p. 2 tog. 10TH ROW: Rib 16, slip 1, k. 2 tog., p.s.s.o., rib 15, k. 2 tog. 11TH ROW: Rib 31, p. 2 tog. 12TH ROW: Storm blue wool—rib 14, slip 1, k. 2 tog., p.s.s.o., rib 13, k. 2 tog. 13TH ROW: Rib 27, p. 2 tog. 14TH ROW: Yellow wool—rib 12, slip 1, k. 2 tog., p.s.s.o., rib 11, k. 2 tog. 15TH ROW: Rib 23, p. 2 tog. 16TH ROW: Rib 10, slip 1, k. 2 tog., p.s.s.o., rib 9, k. 2 tog. 17TH ROW: Rib 19, p. 2 tog. 18TH ROW: Storm blue wool—rib 8, slip 1, k. 2 tog., p.s.s.o., rib 7, k. 2 tog. 19TH ROW: Rib 15, p. 2 tog. 20TH ROW: Rust wool—rib 6, slip 1, k. 2 tog., p.s.s.o., rib 5, k. 2 tog. 21ST ROW: Rib 11, p. 2 tog. 22ND ROW: Rib 4, slip 1, k. 2 tog., p.s.s.o.,
